



Sunshine Skyway Fishing Pier

Partial Demolition

FPNs: 427370-1-52-01 (North) & 427993-1-52-01 (South)

This project is being conducted by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).

Project Location: The Sunshine Skyway Fishing Piers are located at the north and south entrances to the Bob Graham Sunshine Skyway Bridge. The North Pier is located in Pinellas County and the South Pier is located in Manatee County.

Project Purpose: Portions of the Sunshine Skyway Fishing Piers, located behind the fencing on the piers, were determined to be structurally unsafe. In the interest of public safety, FDOT and its contractor will remove access to the structurally unsafe portions. The contractor will remove certain spans and the associated piles within the pier but not all of them. (See diagram on the right)

Project Description:

- Remove light poles
- Remove fencing and replace with masonry block wall and barriers
- Building renovation at restroom crossovers and bait shop
- Partial demolition of the North and South Skyway Fishing Piers
 - North Pier – 27 spans removed
 - South Pier – 48 spans removed

Most of the work will be performed from floating barges except for building renovations. According to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) boaters are advised to keep clear of the piers by 100 feet.

Bait Shops: There are bait shops located on the North and South piers. These bait shops will remain open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week throughout this project.

Contractor: Misener Marine

Construction Managers: PB Americas, Inc.

Project Costs: FDOT project is \$2.2 million.

Contractor's Schedule:

- The contractor will begin the week of June 20, 2011 by removing light poles and fixtures.
- Demolition and removal of spans will begin in early July 2011.
- NO WEEKEND WORK IS EXPECTED.
